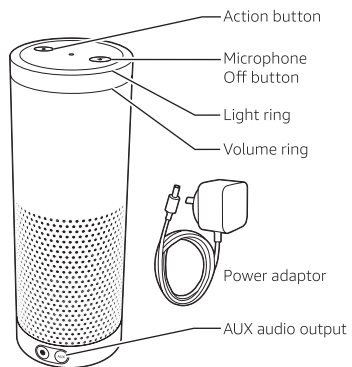


Getting to know Echo Plus



Action button

You can use this button to turn off the alarm and timer. You can also use this button to wake up Echo Plus.

Microphone Off button

Press this button to turn off the microphones. The Microphone Off button and light ring will turn red. Press it again to turn the microphones back on.

Light ring

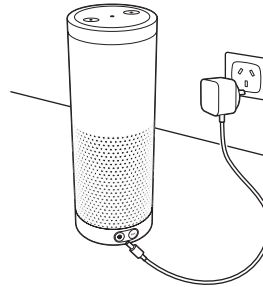
The colour of the light ring indicates what Echo Plus is doing. When the light ring is blue, Echo Plus is ready for your requests.

Volume ring

Turn the dial clockwise to increase the volume. The light ring fills in as the volume increases.

1. Plug in your Echo Plus

Plug the power adaptor into Echo Plus and then into an electrical socket. You must use the items included in the original Echo Plus package for optimal performance. A blue light ring will begin to spin around the top. In about a minute, the light ring will change to orange and Alexa will greet you.



2. Download the Alexa App

Download the Alexa App from the app store.

The app helps you get more out of your Echo Plus. It's where you see an overview of your requests and manage your lists, news, music and settings.

You can also start the setup process from your computer browser at <https://alexa.amazon.com.au>.

If the setup process does not start automatically, go to Settings > Set up a new device.

During setup, you will connect your Echo Plus to the Internet, so you can access Amazon services. Please make sure you have your Wi-Fi password.

Where to put your Echo Plus

Echo Plus works best when placed in a central location, at least twenty centimetres from any wall. You can put Echo Plus in a variety of places—on a kitchen counter, the coffee table in your living room or a bedside table.

Talking to Echo Plus

To get the attention of your Echo Plus, simply say "Alexa". When you are ready to set up your smart home devices, say "Alexa, discover my devices" and then power on your smart home devices.
