



### Congratulations on the purchase of this Self Inflating Mat.

In making this choice you have decided in favour of comfort and are ensured luxurious relaxation.

Due to a combination of open cell foam and airtight vinyl and velour backing, this mattress offers excellent insulating properties and is at the same time a comfortable underlay.

#### The advantages of this Self Inflating Mattress:

- Luxurious sleep thanks to an extremely comfortable mattress
- CFC- Free, extra-thick open-cell foam prevents insulating losses due to heat conduction
- The airproof and waterproof NON-SLIP outer fabric (backing) is tough, light, dries quickly and is easy to clean
- As a result of the NON-SLIP fabric, tiresome slippage between sleeping bag and mattress is reduced
- NON-SLIP is used for both sides of the mattress so that slippage on smooth tent floors is also reduced
- This Self Inflating Mat inflates rapidly automatically forming a comfortable underlay.
- The foam core remains pliable and won't become brittle or stiff even at extremely low temperatures

#### Inflating Your Mat

1. Open valve
2. The foam core in the interior of the mattress expands and draws air through the valve.  
The mattress inflates automatically.
3. Close valve when the desired thickness is attained.
4. Find a suitable place to lie. Protect your foam mattress from sharp objects.
5. Do not leave valve closed when not lying on mattress.

#### Deflating Your Mat

1. Open valve
2. Roll the mattress in the direction of the valve forcing the air out of the mattress in this way.  
TIP: In order to let the air out more easily and rapidly lie on the mattress with the valve open.  
This will result in a large amount of the air being forced out by the weight of your body.  
Only then should the mattress be rolled up slowly. Press the remaining air out with your knees at every turn.  
It may be necessary to re roll the mattress 2 or 3 times to remove enough air for the mattress to fit into its carry bag
3. Close valve. In this form the mattress can be transported compactly as a roll in the transport sack.

#### At Extremely Low Temperatures

If temperatures are very low, it is possible that your Self-inflating mat will inflate more slowly than you are used to. Your body temperature can help the mattress to inflate: Lie down on the rolled out mattress and 'warm' the 'chilled' foam core.

DO NOT BLOW UP THE MATTRESS !

Breath is moist and can crystallise in the mattress or in the valve impeding further use.

#### Transportation:

When transporting your mat protect it from sharp-edged or pointed objects and from abrasion. Always use the transport sack supplied with the mattress. Never expose the mattress to great heat over long periods.

#### Storage:

If you don't use your mat for a long period of time, open the valve and store your mattress unrolled in a dry place (wardrobe, under the bed.). If the mattress should remain moist too long, it is possible that mould could destroy the cover and inner.

#### Cleaning:

Ensure that the valve is closed. Clean your mat with mild soapsuds and/or with a soft brush. Afterwards rinse off well and leave to dry in a cool place out of direct sun light.

#### Repairs:

Patching your mat is made very easy with the purchase of a repair kit. (available from most specialist camping retailers)

1. In order to find leaks, inflate the mattress. Then either hold it under water or spray it with a fine film of water. Small air bubbles will reveal possible leaks. Mark these and let your mat dry. Let the air out of the mattress and close the valve.
2. In the case of small punctures (prick point) place one or two drops of glue onto the leaks. Let these dry for at least 1 hour before using the mattress.
3. When repairing larger punctures spread the glue thinly with a circular motion on to the dry, clean and possibly lightly roughened surface. Remove the protective paper from the patch and spread a thin layer of glue also onto the back of the patch Make sure the patch doesn't come into contact with the wet glue! After glue has dried (after approx. 3 minutes) position the patch on the mattress and press down stroking lightly from the centre outwards. Avoiding forming blisters and creases. Afterwards press down firmly and leave to dry for at least 60 minutes (should the tears exceed 1 cm in length, leave for 120 minutes), NB. 24 hours is better. When humid or when temperatures are lower than 5C, drying time lengthen by 50%.

#### WARNING!

Glue is highly inflammable! Not to be used in the proximity of naked flames, sparks or heat sources!

#### WARNING!

Glue can damage your health.  
Only to be used in rooms which are adequately ventilated.  
Don't inhale fumes and avoid contact with skin.

#### FIRST AID:

In the event of glue coming into contact with the eyes, rinse with plenty of water for at least 10 minutes.  
Seek medical advice immediately.
