## **WARNING**

This cot has been designed for a child up to 25kg

Do not leave your child unattended when the dropside is in the lower position

**RECOMMENDED MATTRESS SIZE:** This cot has been manufactured for use with a mattress which measure 760mm wide by 1310mm long and 130mm in thickness.

The width and length are specific because it is important that the gaps between the mattress and the sides and ends of the cot will not exceed 40mm. This is to minimize the risk of a child's limb becoming caught in the gap. The thickness of the mattress has been specified to ensure that the depth of the cot is greater than 500mm with the mattress base in the lower position to minimise the risk of a child climbing or falling out of the cot.

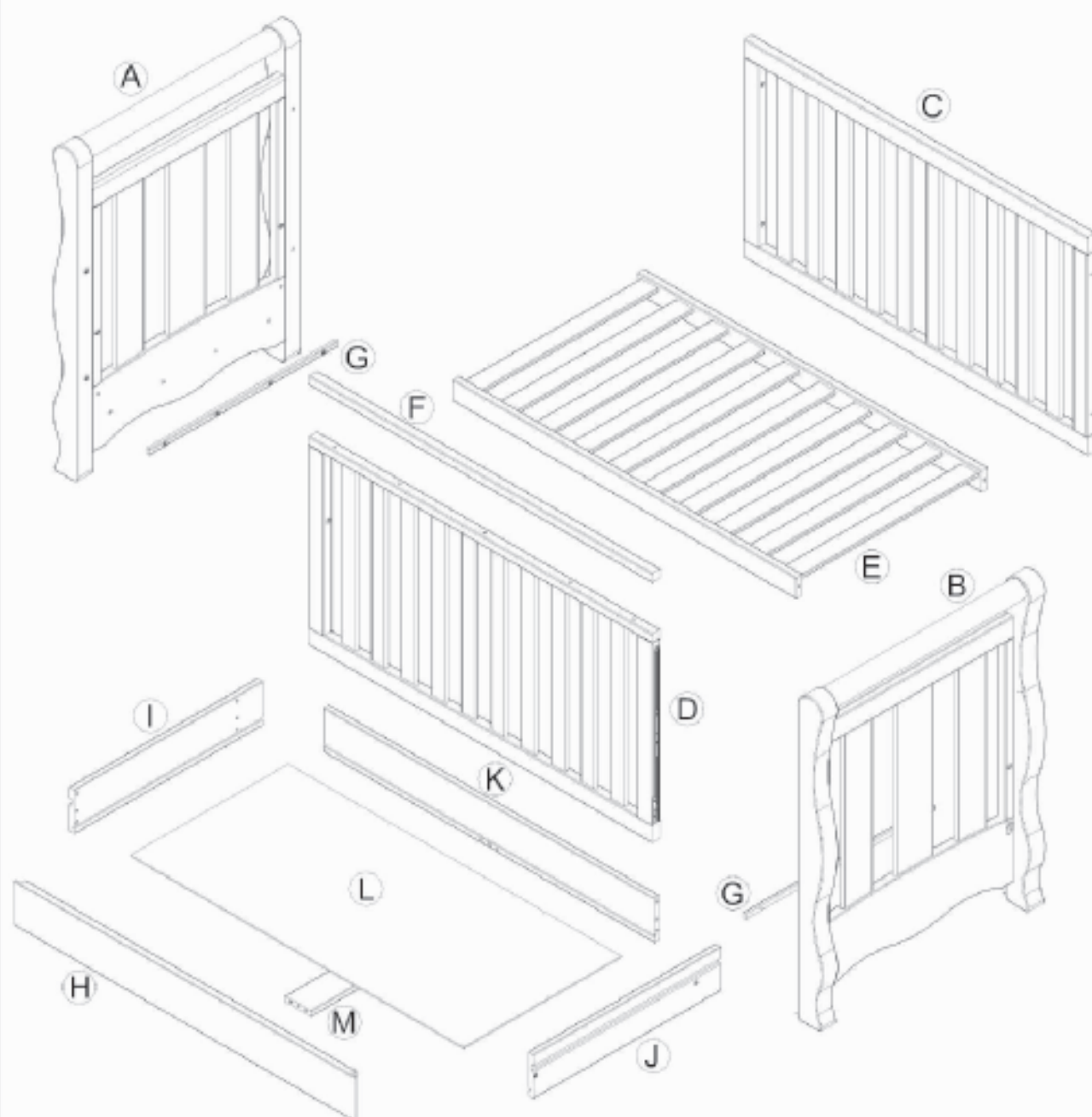
**WARNING TO PREVENT FALLS, THE MATTRESS BASE OF THIS COT SHOULD BE ADJUSTED TO THE LOWEST POSITION BEFORE THE CHILD CAN SIT UP.**

The manufacturer's assembly instructions must be followed in detail to ensure all the safety features of the cot are not compromised.

Please ensure that the cot is placed at a reasonable distance from curtains, blinds, heaters and power points.

Please keep medication, string, elastic, small toys or small items, such as money out of reach from any position in the cot.

## Step 1 SETTING UP THE ENDS

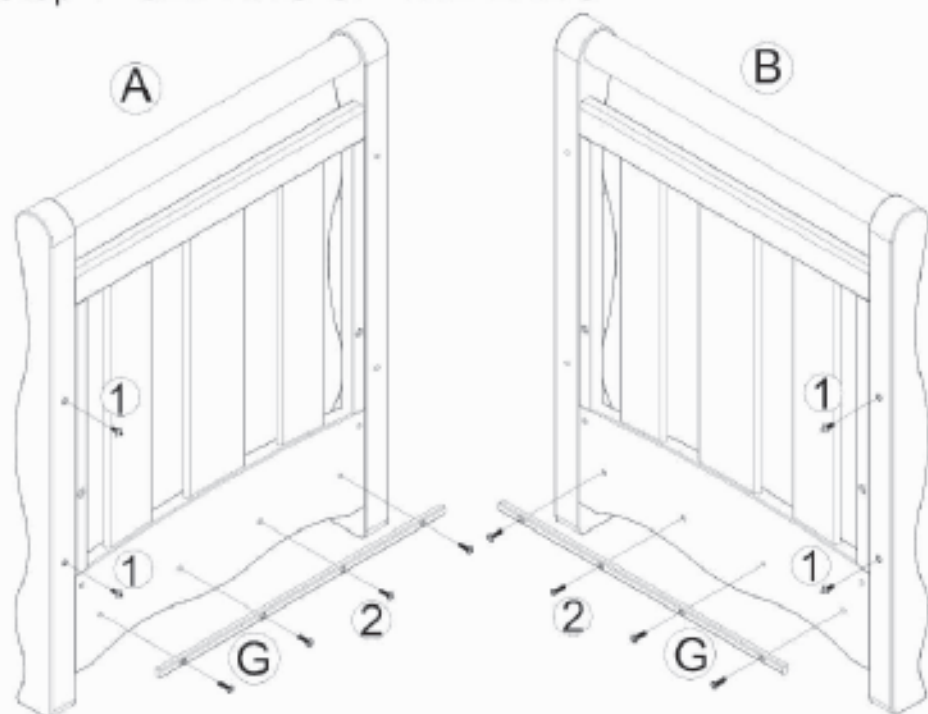

2. Attach 2pcs Support Rails (G) to Left End (A) and Right End (B), Using 8pcs Bolts (2) with Allen Key (13). See Figure 2.

## Step 2 ASSEMBLING THE DROP SIDE

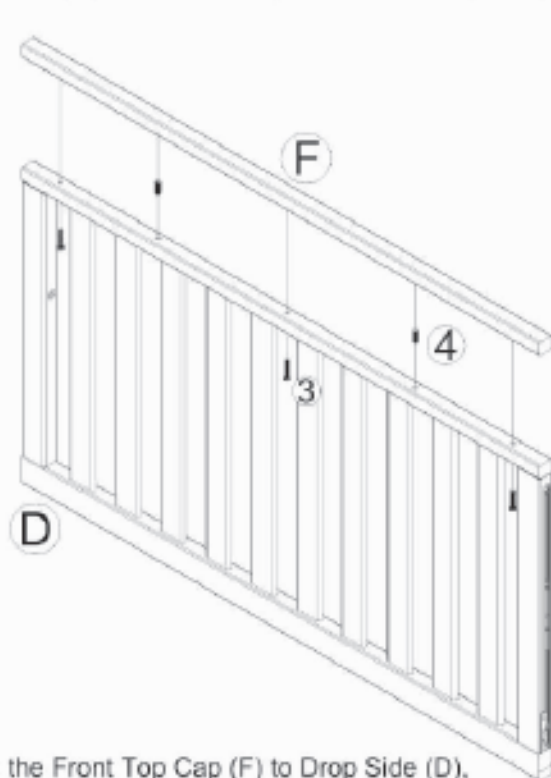

## Step 3 ATTACHING THE DROPSIDE TO THE ENDS

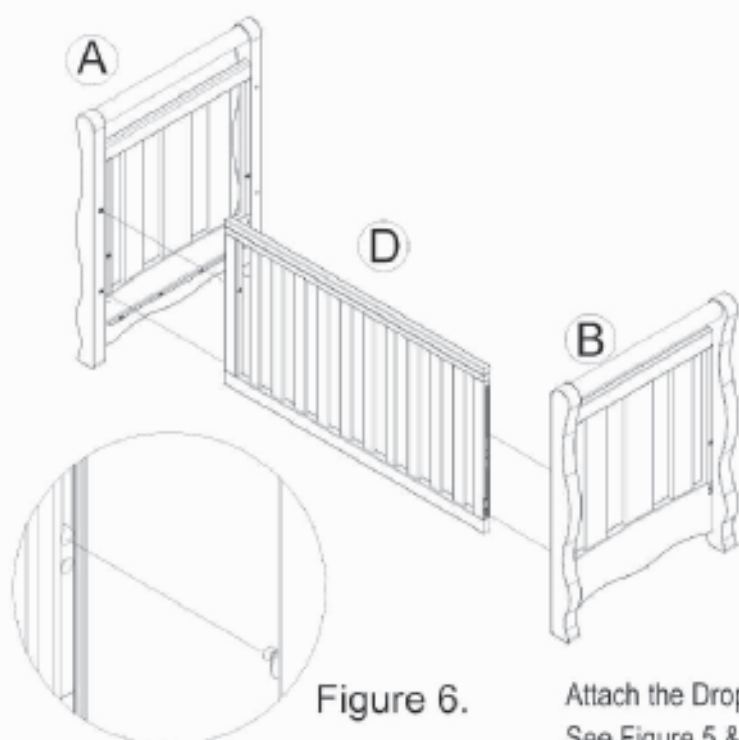

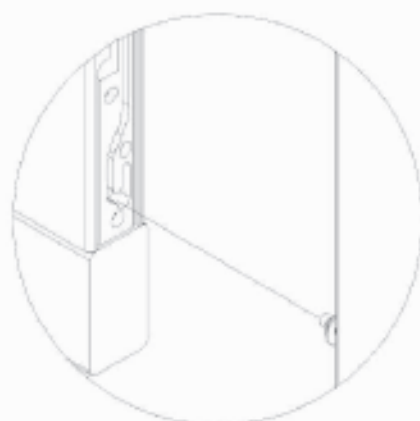

## Step 4 ATTACHING THE DROPSIDE TO THE ENDS

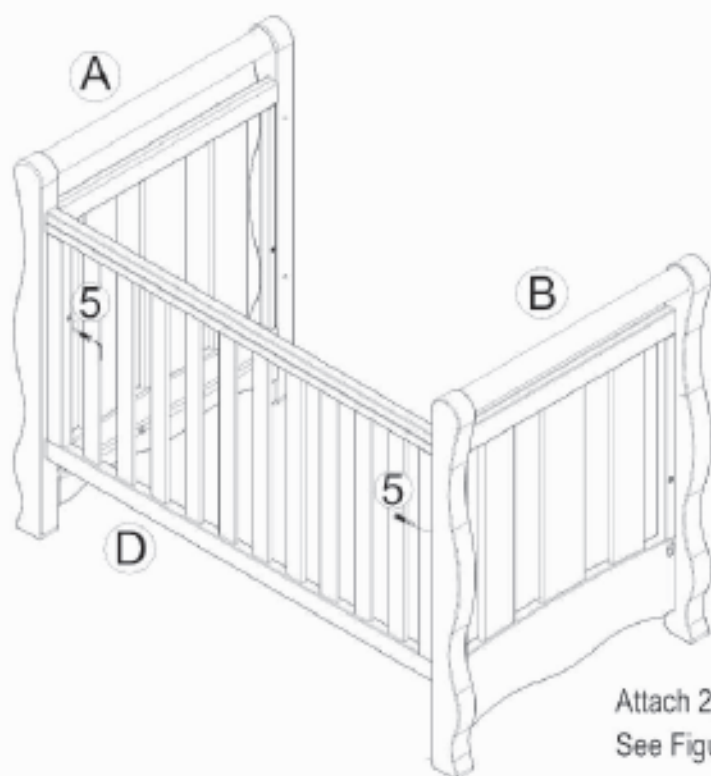

## Step 5 ATTACHING THE BASE TO THE ENDS AND DROPSIDE

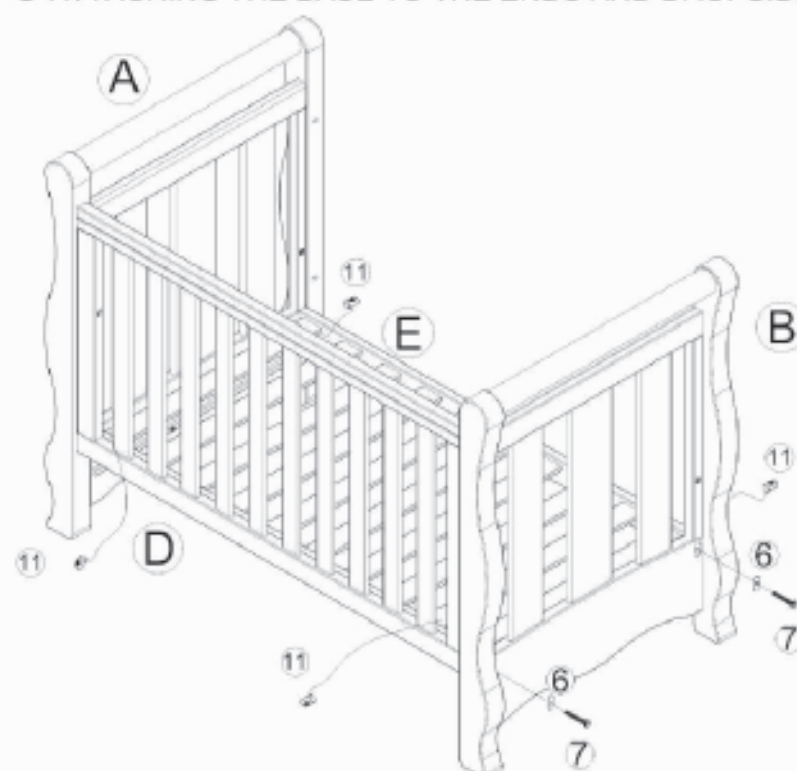

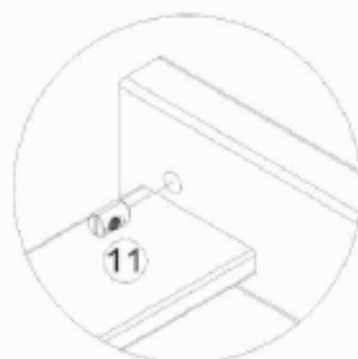

## Step 6 ATTACHING FIXED SIDE

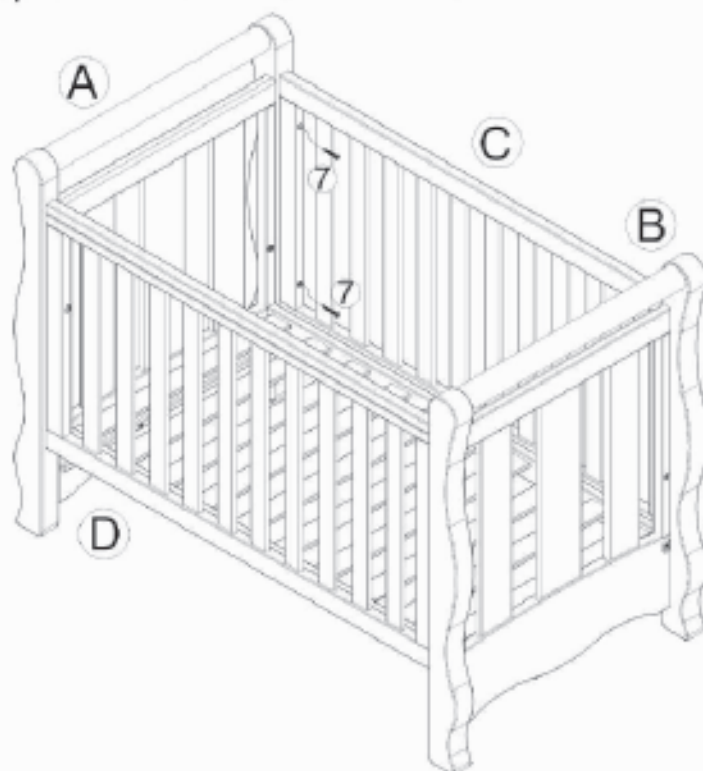

## Step 7 ASSEMBLING THE DRAWER

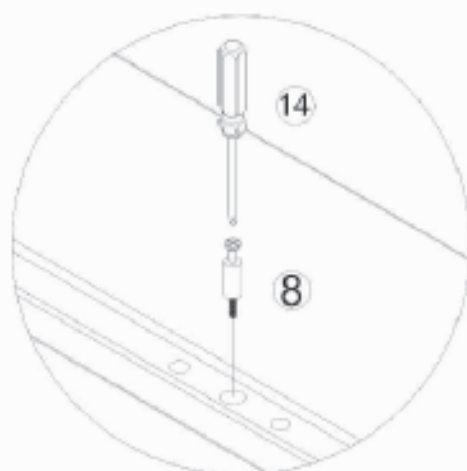
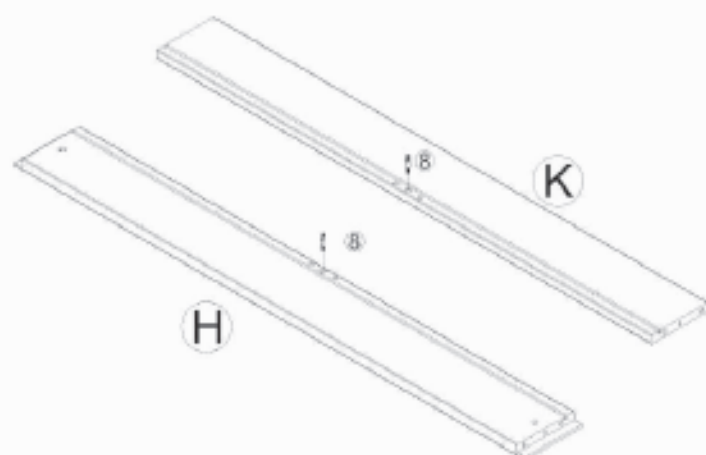

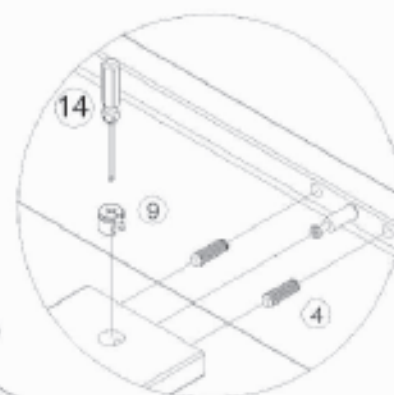

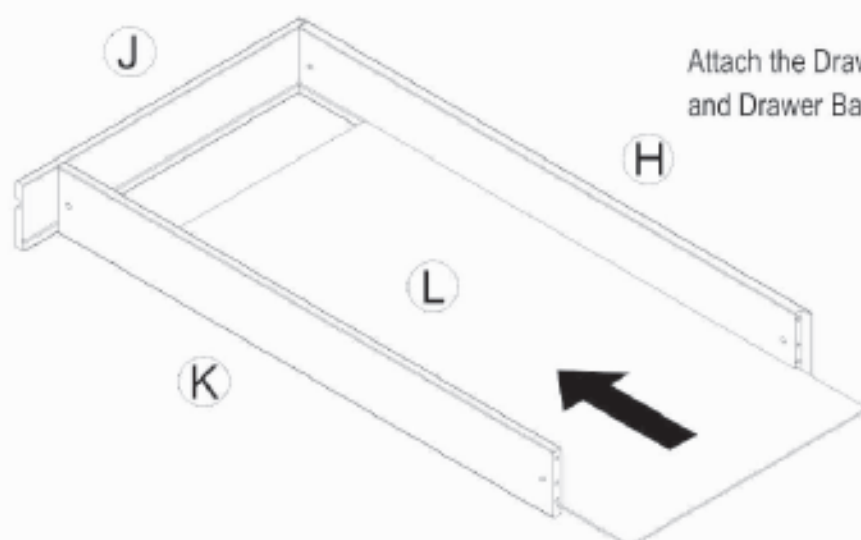
Attach the Drawer Bottom Rail (M) to Drawer Front (H) and Drawer Back (K),

Attach the Drawer Side Right (J) to Drawer Front (H) and Drawer Back (K), using 4pcs Wood Dowels (4), 2pcs Bolts (10) and 2pcs Nuts (11) with Allen Key (13). See Figure (13).

## Step 10 INSERTING THE DRAWER BASE



Attach the Drawer Bottom (L) to Drawer Front (H) and Drawer Back (K).

## Step 11 ATTACHING ENDS IN DRAWER

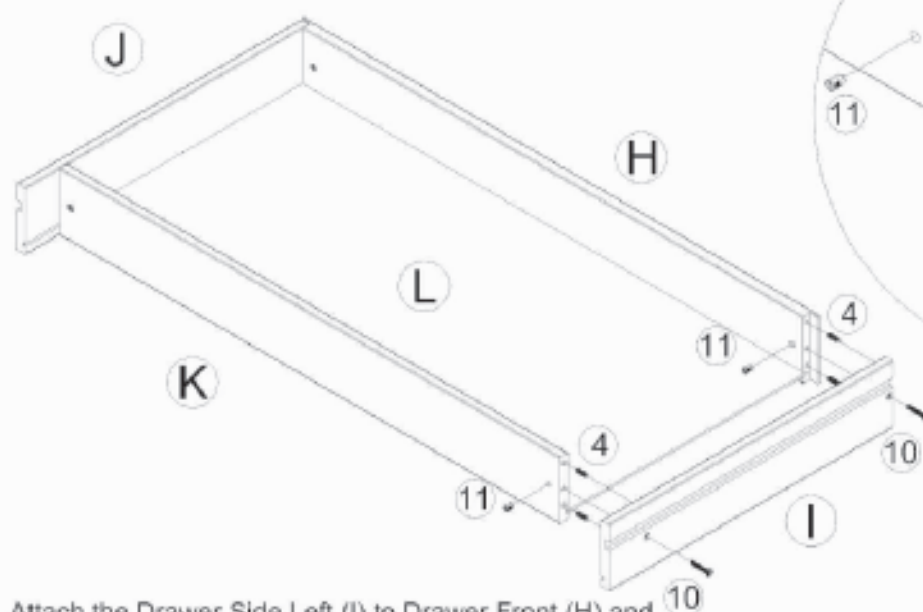
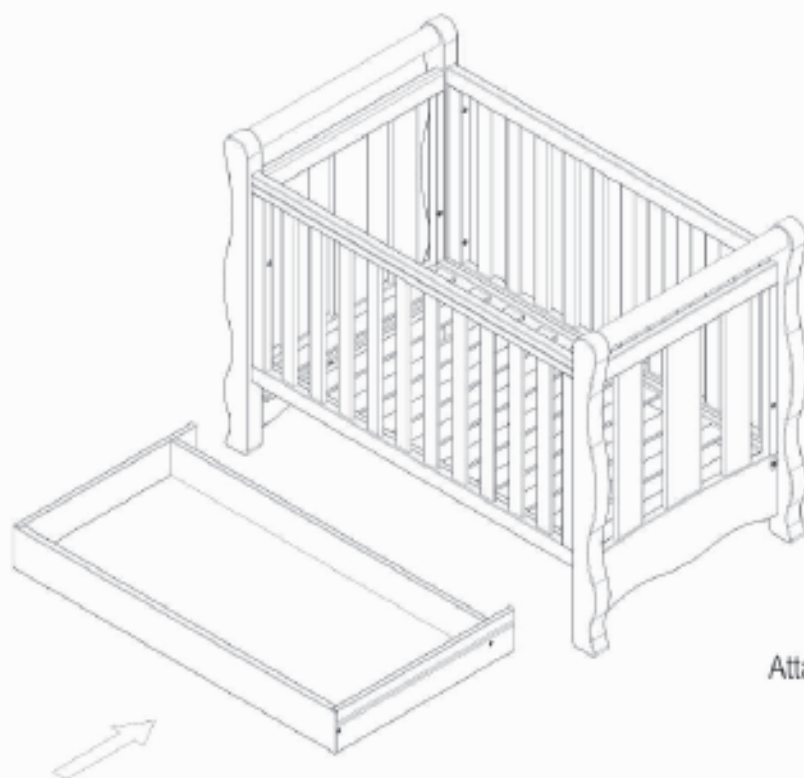

## HOW TO ADJUST THE MATTRESS BASE

Before raise the Mattress Base to the highest Position. Take out the bolts that are inside the holes.

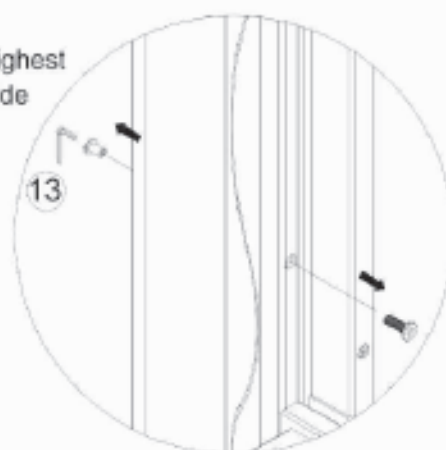

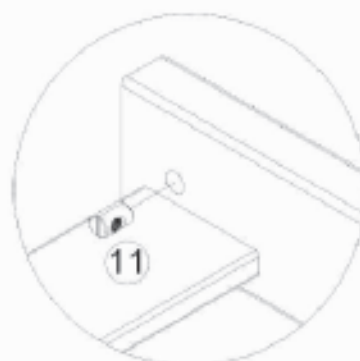

1. Attach 4pcs Bolts (15) and 4pcs Nuts (11) to Left & Right Sides to Fix the Mattress Base. See Figure 16 & 17.
2. Attach 4pcs Bolts (2) and 4pcs Iron Plates (6) and 4 pcs Caps to Fill of the holes. See Figure 18.

Warning : Ensure unused Mattress Base mounting holes on the end Panels are blanked off with the supplied blanking Screws and tightened to prevent to finger entrapment and swallowing hazards.

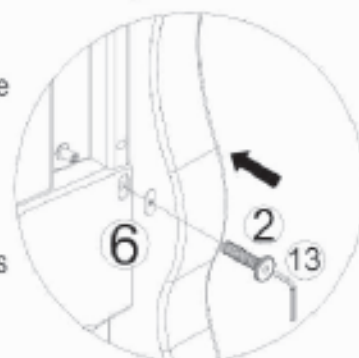

TO CONVERT THE COT INTO A SOFA

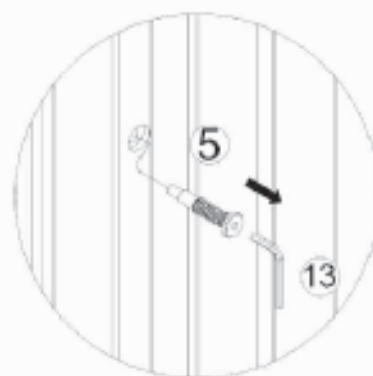

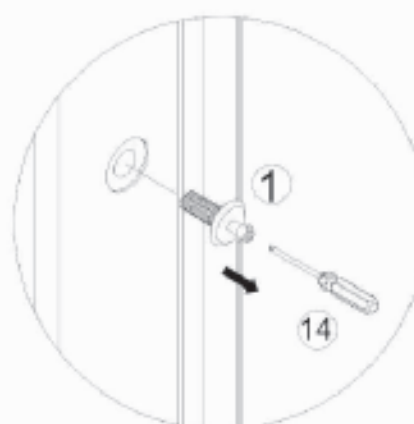

TO CONVERT THE SOFA TO A TODDLER BED

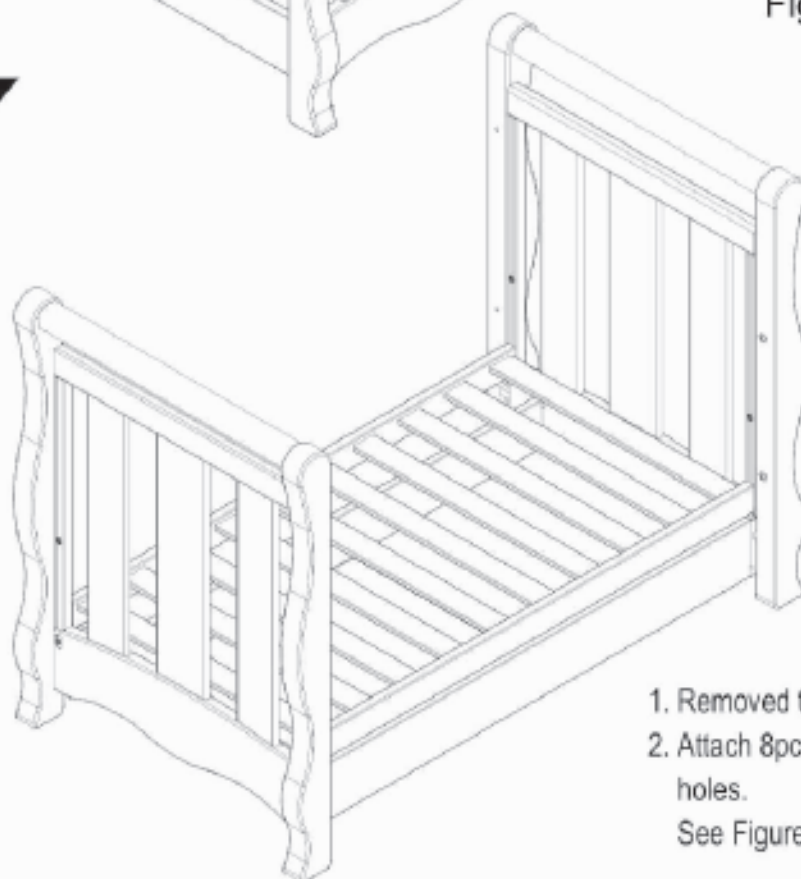
